

The FIOC Scholarship

Requirements

- Completed Application form (attached). Return completed application by the dead line (January 31, 2021) to the following address in care of Scholarship Evaluating Committee: **FIOC, Inc. P.O. Box 901, Farmington, CT 06034-901**
- Applicant (or family) must be FIOC member for at least two consecutive years (2019 and 2020).
- Essay. (Consult application form for details and please use separate sheet of papers). Both essay questions must be answered,
- Resume (one page),
- High School Transcript. Ask your high school principal or guidance counselor to mail a copy of your high school transcript to FIOC address above no later than the due date,
- SAT/ACT Scores. Ask your high school principal or guidance counselor to mail a copy of your College Board scores to FIOC address above no later than the due date.
- Community Services log,
- Student signature for Validity of Information,
- Letters of Recommendations (2),
- Appear before the Scholarship Evaluating Committee for Personal Interview (if requested),
- Recipient must enter the college or university of their choice no later than the Fall term, and maintain a full time status (must submit a copy of Fall registration) following the acceptance of the award. Exception will be reviewed by the Scholarship Board Committee.
- Award recipient(s) will be announced in Iranian New Year's Celebration, (Nowruz Party held March of each year),
- Award will be presented to the recipient(s) during Mehregan celebration (October of each year).
- Recipient(s) must notify Scholarship Board Committee of acceptance or refusal of the scholarship within 10 days of notification of the award.
