

## The FIOC Scholarship Requirements

- Completed Application form (attached). Return completed application by the deadline (January 31, 2024) to the following address in care of Scholarship Evaluating Committee:  
**FIOC, Inc. P.O. Box 901, Farmington, CT 06034-901**
- Applicants (or family) must be FIOC members for at least two consecutive years (2023 and 2024). 2023 membership for CT residents are waived because of the Covid. 2024 membership application and membership fee must be included with the Scholarship application.
- Essay (Consult application form for details). Essay questions must be answered,
- Resume (one page),
- High School Transcript. Ask your high school principal or guidance counselor to mail a copy of your high school transcript to FIOC address above no later than the due date,
- SAT/ACT Scores. Ask your high school principal or guidance counselor to mail a copy of your College Board scores to FIOC address above no later than the due date,
- Community Services log ( If it is available),
- Student signature for Validity of Information,
- Letters of Recommendations (2),
- Appear before the Scholarship Evaluating Committee for Personal or virtual Interview (if requested),
- Recipients must enter the college or university of their choice no later than the Fall term, and maintain a full time status (must submit a copy of Fall registration) following the acceptance of the award. Exceptions will be reviewed by the Scholarship Board Committee.
- Scholarship varies each year depending on the number of applicants and availability of funds, previous recipients have received up to \$2000,
- Award will be announced in the Iranian New Year's Celebration, (Nowruz Party held March of each year),
- Award will be presented to the recipient(s) during Mehregan celebration (October of each year).
- Recipient(s) must notify Scholarship Board Committee of acceptance or refusal of the scholarship within 10 days of notification of the award.
